


#### Highlights of the Month

PFC Achieves Record Dividend Payout of ₹4,455 Crore for FY 2023-24, including ₹462 Crore to Government of India

PFC achieved a record-high dividend payout of ₹4,455 crore for FY 2023-24! This includes a significant final dividend of ₹462 crore to the Government of India and ₹363 crore to shareholders.

Smt. Parminder Chopra, CMD, presented the final dividend to Shri Manohar Lal, Hon'ble Union Minister of Power, Housing & Urban, and Shri Pankaj Agarwal, Secretary, Power, Govt. of India, in the presence of Shri Manoj Sharma, Director (Commercial) & Shri Sandeep Kumar, Director (Finance), PFC.



#### PFC signs MoA with MMRDA for multiple infrastructure projects in Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR)

PFC signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) for nine key infrastructure projects being implemented to improve connectivity across the Mumbai Metropolitan Region. Notably among the multiple projects covered under MoA are the Thane-Borivali Twin Tube Tunnel, a significant project that will reduce travel time and ease traffic congestion, the Thane Coastal Road, the Elevated Eastern Freeway extension from Ghatkopar to Thane, Elevated corridor from Anand Nagar to Saket on Eastern Express highway, Road & Creek bridge from Thane to Bhiwandi and Gaimukh to Payegaon. As per the MoA, PFC shall provide financial assistance through a Rupee Term Loan of ₹31,673.79 crore to MMRDA.

MMRDA is engaged in long-term planning, promotion of new growth centres, implementation of strategic projects, and financing infrastructure development in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR). With the collaboration of these two giants, connectivity across MMR is set for a significant facelift in the coming years, which aligns with Regional Development Plans for MMR's sustainable growth.


#### PFC's Shashank Maheshwari Wins Third Prize in Individual Category at Inter CPSU Chess Tournament 2024

Power Finance Corporation (PFC), a Maharatna Company and a leading NBFC in the power sector, has paid Rs 462 crore to the government and Rs 363 crore to other shareholders, totalling Rs 825 crore as the Final Dividend for the financial year 2023-24.

For the Financial Year 2023-24, PFC paid Rs 4455 crore dividend, out of which Rs 2,495 crore, including the final dividend of Rs 462 crore, was paid to Government of India against 55.99% of shareholding.

This is the highest-ever

dividend paid by PFC in any Financial Year.

The first, second & third interim dividend @45%, 35% & 30% % i.e. Rs 4.5, Rs 3.5 & Rs 3 per equity share of face value Rs 10 each, respectively, were declared by the board of directors earlier in November 2023, February 2024, and March 2024 in addition to the final dividend @25% i.e. Rs 2.5 per equity share for the financial year 2023-24.
